Resolution introduced by Supervisors Kenny, Strainer, Belden, Pitkin and McDevitt

AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE WARREN COUNTY BICENTENNIAL CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE - COUNTY CLERK

WHEREAS, the County of Warren as a unit of government was established by an act of the New York State Legislature on March 12, 1813 (Chapter L, Laws of New York 1813 (136th session), thereby separating the area from the original County of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the County of Warren is now approaching its 200th anniversary as a unit of government responsible for serving the residents of Warren County and providing services as well to all visitors, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors seeks to recognize the County of Warren on the occasion of its bicentennial by making the necessary preparations for a series of meaningful events in the County's honor, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby establishes the Warren County Bicentennial Citizens Advisory Committee for the purpose of identifying and coordinating a series of meaningful events, many and varied, to be held throughout the County during the Bicentennial Year, 2013, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, authorized to appoint such members to the Committee as deemed appropriate and necessary for a successful Bicentennial commemoration.
